

Brooke Media Center Overview



The Media Center Staff anticipates a very busy year for the Brooke Elementary School Media Center. Last year, the Media Center circulated 26,297 books and audio-visual materials. We're gearing up to surpass that number this year.

Once again, the Media Center is offering grade level reading clubs for interested students. This is an optional reading opportunity that is available in grades 1 - 4. The themes for this year are:

Grade 1: Franklin Fan Club

Grade 2: Arthur Fan Club

Grade 3: Animal Fan Club

Grade 4: Biography Fan Club

Each reading club has a yearly goal of 10 books that need to be read by the student. Each student who attain their goal are recognized on a monthly basis as well as a yearly basis. During the month of September, all students are involved in library orientation, which reviews the different sections of the library, kinds of books located in these sections, book check-out procedures, and use of place savers.

Throughout the year, students in all grade levels complete skill related activities and worksheets that correlate with the library curriculum, research, or author featured for that week. These worksheets are corrected by the librarian and sent home with the students. Parents should take the opportunity to look over these worksheets so that they are aware of what their students are doing during the weekly library class.
